<u>4-09/015.00</u> <u>FIRES</u>			<p>Notification shall be made to Arson/Explosives Detail by telephone as soon as possible regarding any fire that requires a written report.</p> <p>Type of investigation to request:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Immediate</u>: When suspect is present or arrested, when incendiary evidence may be destroyed or contaminated if investigation is delayed or when there is loss of life or injuries are critical. • <u>Routine</u>: When suspicious circumstances are involved or when no critical injury is involved. <p>Fire reports are not required when the loss is less than \$7,500 and the cause is clearly accidental. A report is necessary, regardless of loss, when there is suspected arson, another crime and/or any suspicions of foul play. Field supervisors should monitor fire calls whenever possible.</p>

SH-R-49 required in addition to SH-R-84. Code 275 - Arson - community/public property. NOTE: If person dead, use priority 49, code 496.

<p>Vehicle (suspicious) in fire area</p>	<p>SH-CR-169 (FIR)</p>		<p>When assigned to mountain areas, brush areas or other fire hazard areas, the Deputy shall submit a report whenever he deems a vehicle or its occupants suspicious or requiring further checking. Special attention should be given to vehicles with a lone occupant.</p> <p>Copy of report to be sent to Arson/Explosives Detail.</p>
