Identity theft 530.5(a) PC (Refer to varieties of Identity Theft and related instructions for details of assignment)	SHR-49 URN 11		Unlawful use of personal information to obtain credit, goods, services, or medical information without the consent of that person. Law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over victim's residence shall take a police report and provide complainant with a copy. If crime occurred in different jurisdiction, refer the investigation to the law enforcement agency where suspected crime was committed. "Jurisdiction" means where property, goods services or medical information is received.

Identity Theft (goods) 530.5(a) PC	SHR-49 URN 11	Identity Theft Detail A	Goods received within LASD Jurisdiction. "Goods" defined as property. Code 117 - Identity Theft Detail (goods/services/credit)
Identity Theft (goods) 530.5(a) PC (outside LASD jurisdiction)	SHR-49 URN 11	Station/unit detectives P	Assign to agency having jurisdiction where goods received; SRD to identity Theft Detail. NOTE: "SRD" Identity Theft Detail Code 117 - Identity Theft Detail (goods/services/credit)
Identity Theft(services) 530.5(a) PC	SHR-49 URN 11	Identity Theft Detail A	Services received in LASD jurisdiction. Example - medical services.

Ensure victim of ID compromise has copy of crime report and necessary fraud alerts/reporting made to credit bureaus/Federal Trade Commission.</p> <p>If victim company desirous of prosecution, coordinate investigation with company’s fraud investigator.</p> <p>Code 118 - Identity Theft Detail (Utilities)</p>

Identity theft (social security number) 530.5(a) PC	SHR-49 URN 11	Social Security Administration P	All cases involving social security numbers only will be forwarded to the Social Security Administration. If compromise involves employment, forward copy of report to the Employment Development Department. NOTE: "SRD" Identity Theft Detail Code 119 - Identity Theft Detail (profiles)
Identity theft (income tax) 530.5(a) PC	SHR-49 URN 11	Station/unit detectives	Refer victim to Tax Payer Advocacy Unit. Indicate nature of income reported and dates assessed in crime report. Forward to the Internal Revenue Service or Franchise Tax Board to handle case. NOTE: "SRD" Identity Theft Detail Code 119 - Identity Theft Detail (profiles)
Identity theft custody cases			
Utilities only	SHR-49 URN 11	Station/unit detectives A	Handle accordingly. Code 118 - Identity Theft Detail (utilites)
Identity thefts (all others)	SHR-49 URN 11	Identity Theft Detail A	During business hours-immediate notifications to Fraud Unit. After business hours, weekends and holidays-notify Sheriff's Headquarters Bureau. Code 117 - Identity Theft Detail (goods/services/credit)
Identity thefts (reasonable cause arrests)	SHR-49 URN 60	Identity Theft Detail A	Non utility case/Immediate notification to Fraud Unit - Identity Theft Detail or Sheriff's Headquarters Bureau after hours. Code 609 - Reasonable cause arrest (all other felonies)

Identity thefts where crime undetermined and "Suspicious Circumstances"	SHR-49 URN 44	Identity Theft Detail or station/unit detectives A	Document nature of identity compromise based on information available from victim. If act involves utilities, refer to section marked "utilities" for assignment. Code 444 - Suspicious circumstances, possible criminal activity
Identity theft involving fraudulently obtained vehicles	SHR-49 URN 11	Identity Theft Detail A	Station/unit detectives MUST verify with dealer vehicle fraudulently obtained via means involving Identity Theft. If LASD jurisdiction, prepare CHP-180 and enter into SVS. Prepare supplemental report of facts and REASSIGN to Identity Theft Detail. If outside LASD jurisdiction, do not enter into SVS. Forward case to proper law enforcement agency for follow-up investigation and SRD to Identity Theft Detail. NOTE: "SRD" Identity Theft Detail Code 117 - Identity Theft Detail (goods/services/credit)
Identity theft involving "Attempts"	SHR-49 URN 11	Station/unit detectives P	All cases involving attempts will be documented. If outside LASD, refer to proper agency. NOTE: "SRD" Identity Theft Detail Code 119 - Identity Theft Detail (profiles)
Identity theft (possession of profiles) 530.5(a) PC	SH-R-49 URN 11	Identity Theft Detail A	Code 119 - Identity Theft Detail (profiles)

Wearing of U.S. Military Uniform	SH-R-49 URN 30	Station/unit detective A	Station/unit detectives shall notify the Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI). Code 308 - Federal offense - not involving theft or money.

<p>Employee exposed to smoke and/or fire fumes</p>	<p>SH-R-426A URN 50</p>	<p>Disability Management Compliance Unit A</p>	<p>Prepare Form SH-R-426A, Smoke and Fire Exposure Report, for each employee who responds to a fire and is exposed to fumes/smoke inhalation. Place the original report in the employee's medical file and email a copy to the Disability Management and Compliance Unit Help Desk.</p> <p>A URN is not required if an employee does not seek medical treatment.</p> <p>If an employee seeks immediate medical attention or seeks treatment at any time due to experiencing symptoms or complications after being exposed to smoke/fumes, an industrial injury claim should be completed. At that time, a URN should be pulled. A copy of the Smoke and Fire Exposure Report (SH-R-426A) shall be attached to the injury packet, as well as the same URN from the injury packet.</p> <p>The original packet shall be placed in the employee's unit medical file, and a copy sent to the Disability Management and Compliance Unit's DMCU Injury Reports email group.</p> <p>If a Reserve Deputy is involved, also send a copy to Reserve Forces Bureau.</p> <p>Code 502 - Injury to County Employee.</p>

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4-12/020.00 INVESTIGATIONS			
Confidential	URN 44		Assigned by appropriate bureaus only. Files shall be maintained by the individual bureau. Report retention period to be assigned by bureau.
Routine	URN 44		Assigned by appropriate detail only. These codes are for use by details for routine types of investigations other than assigned crimes or arrests. Examples: Pawnshop investigations, business license investigations, inspections, gun sale investigations, etc. Report retention period to be assigned by detail. Individual files or records of these activities may be kept at the detail or filed at the Records and Identification Bureau.
Special	URN 44		To be assigned by appropriate bureau or detail only. Individual files may be kept as confidential by the unit concerned. Report retention period to be assigned by appropriate bureau or detail. This category is intended for non-routine, extensive investigations where no specific crime or arrest for a crime in our area is being investigated or reported. Code 441 - Special investigation.
