Battery, juvenile victim or subject of	SH-R-49 URN 14	Station/Unit Patrol A/P	Case shall be assigned to Station/Unit patrol when all the following apply: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • victim is a juvenile; • suspect is an adult who has been identified; and • there appears to be no further investigation needed. Victim to be referred to the area court Deputy for the signing of a complaint. Cases which do not meet the above conditions shall be assigned to Station/Unit detectives and made an active assignment. Code as applicable.
Begging, juvenile	SH-R-49 URN 22	Station/Unit Detective A	Code 221 - Loitering/Begging.
Contributing to delinquency of	SH-R-49 URN 39	Station/Unit Detective A	Department of Justice (DOJ) requires MO data. Code 396 - Contributing to Delinquency.
Court Order, violation of (636 WIC)	SH-R-49 URN 39	Station/Unit Detective I	Mandatory detention at juvenile hall. Arresting Deputy must appear at court issuing the court order on the next judicial day following detention. No petition request necessary. Code 399 - Misdemeanor - Miscellaneous.
Destitute	SH-R-49 URN41	Station/Unit Detective A	Refer to juvenile as a victim. Code 411 - Juvenile, Destitute, 300(B) WIC.
Drunk, juvenile	SH-R-49 URN 20	Station/Unit Detective A	Code 201 - Disorderly conduct, drunk.

Incorrigible	SH-R-49 URN 41	Station/Unit Detective A	<p>Incorrigible juveniles shall be arrested and processed through juvenile court in emergency cases only where it can be shown that they present an immediate danger to themselves or to others. In these cases, an incorrigible statement shall be immediately made justifying the emergency need for detention.</p> <p>In all other cases, the parents or guardian shall be directed to contact the local probation office for assistance.</p> <p>Code 414 - Juvenile Incorrigible, 601 WIC.</p>
Lack of supervision	SH-R-49 URN 41	Station/Unit Detective A	<p>Refer to juvenile as a victim, not as suspect or subject.</p> <p>Code 410 - Juvenile, Lack of Supervision, 300(b) WIC.</p>
Loitering/Curfew			See "Loitering."
Minors under 21 driving with a BAC of .01% or greater			See "Vehicle Code Violations - Miscellaneous."
Private person making arrest of juvenile			See "Arrests."
Sex victim	SH-R-49 URN 41	Station/Unit Detective A	<p>See "Sex Offenses."</p> <p>Copy to Special Victims Bureau.</p> <p>Code 416 - Juvenile Sex Victim, Non-Criminal.</p>
Sick			See "Person Injured/Ill."

Transient	SH-R-49 URN 41	Station/Unit Detective A	Transient juveniles (residence outside Los Angeles County) shall be arrested and processed through Juvenile Court when found wandering without a settled place of abode, visible means of support, or proper guardianship within this jurisdiction. Code 413 - Juvenile Transient, Out of State.
Vagrant	SH-R-49 URN 22	Station/Unit Detective A	Code 221 - Loitering/Begging.
