<b><u>4-14/005.00</u></b> <b><u>KIDNAPPING</u></b>			<p>ALL KIDNAPPINGS SHALL BE CONSIDERED CONFIDENTIAL UNTIL CASE RESOLVED</p> <p>Notify station/unit detectives immediately.</p> <p>Do not dispatch a patrol car or uniformed deputies unless ordered to do so by station/unit detectives.</p> <p>If any questions exist regarding an extortion or kidnapping for the purpose of extortion, or if there is credible information that the victim is in imminent danger of serious bodily injury or death, immediately contact the Major Crimes Bureau for procedures or Department resources.</p>
All others not covered below	SH-R-49 URN 32	Station/Unit Detective  A	Notify station/unit detectives immediately.

Kidnapping for the purpose of sex/rape	SH-R-49 URN 12	SVB	<p>Make immediate notification to SVB</p> <p>209(b)(1) PC</p> <p>Use most applicable code.</p>
Victim located, kidnapping for the purpose of robbery	SH-R-49 URN 03 or 04	Station/Unit Detective  A	<p>Make immediate notification to station/unit detectives.</p> <p>Code as applicable.</p>

Victim not located and an indication of ransom, Extortion, robbery, or credible information that the victim is in imminent danger of serious bodily injury or death	SH-R-49 URN 32	MCB  A	<p>Follow instructions found at the beginning of this section. Watch sergeant is to immediately notify Major Crimes Bureau for evaluation and instruction. The safety of the victim is the primary concern. Station/unit detectives are to handle the investigation pending arrival of Major Crimes Bureau personnel and write appropriate report covering their activity.</p> <p>Also see Extortion.</p> <p>Code as applicable:</p> <p>324 - Extortion. 326 - Kidnapping for Ransom.</p>
