3-14/100.00 Emergency Preparedness, Response and Command Policy

An emergency is any significant disruption of normal facility operations, procedures, policy, and /or activities. It shall be the mission of Custody Division during emergency situations to implement measures to:

- Maintain or regain control
- Ensure staff, inmate, and community safety
- Protect life and property
- Restore normal operations

All Custody Division units shall administer continuous emergency preparedness programs and conduct drills emphasizing the following objectives:

- <u>Maximum Prevention</u> through effective management, supervision, training, and identification of risk factors which exist or arise in our operations
- <u>Maximum Readiness</u> through training and preparedness for addressing emergencies which arise in our operations
- <u>Maximum Preparedness</u> to mobilize, command, and coordinate additional resources, as necessary and appropriate
