

6-23/510.00 Withholding Amount

In the case of a non-support order, the maximum amount that can be withheld from an employee's wages is 25% of the employee's disposable earnings or 30 times the federal minimum hourly wage (\$7.25), whichever is less. ([CCP 706.050](#), [15 USC 1673\(a\)](#)) The maximum amount that can be withheld pursuant to an earnings withholding order for support order is 50% minus the amount required to comply with a earnings assignment order. ([CCP 706.052](#)) The Law Revision Commission commented in 706.052 CCP, "If 30 percent of the judgment debtor's earnings are withheld pursuant to a wage assignment for support, an additional 20 percent may be withheld pursuant to the earnings withholding order for the collection of delinquent amounts payable for child or spousal support."
