

6-28/620.00 Unlimited Civil Cases

To appeal an unlimited civil case superior court judgment or order to the Court of Appeal, the appellant must:

- file a Notice of Appeal ([CRC 8.100\(a\)](#))
 - pay the filing fee ([CRC 8.100\(b\)](#))
 - on or before the earliest of:
 - 60 days after the superior court clerk serves on the party filing the notice of appeal a document entitled "Notice of Entry" of judgment or a filed-endorsed copy of the judgment, showing the date either was served ([CRC 8.104\(a\)\(1\)\(A\)](#))
 - 60 days after the party filing the notice of appeal serves or is served by a party with a document entitled "Notice of Entry" of judgment or a filed-endorsed copy of the judgment, accompanied by proof of service ([CRC 8.104\(a\)\(1\)\(B\)](#))
 - 180 days after entry of judgment ([CRC 8.104\(a\)\(1\)\(C\)](#))
