

6-30/740.00 Appeal Period

A Notice of appeal for an unlimited civil cases must be filed in court on or before the earliest of:

- 60 days after the superior court clerk serves on the party filing the notice of appeal a document entitled "Notice of Entry" of judgment or a filed-endorsed copy of the judgment, showing the date either was served ([CRC 8.104\(A\)](#))
- 60 days after the party filing the notice of appeal serves or is served by a party with a document entitled "Notice of Entry" of judgment or a filed-endorsed copy of the judgment, accompanied by proof of service ([CRC 8.104\(B\)](#))
- 180 days after entry of judgment ([CRC 8.104\(C\)](#))

A Notice of appeal for a limited civil cases must be filed in court on or before the earliest of:

- 30 days after the trial court clerk serves the party filing the notice of appeal a document entitled "Notice of Entry" of judgment or a filed-endorsed copy of the judgment, showing the date it was served ([CRC 8.822\(A\)](#))
 - 30 days after the party filing the notice of appeal serves or is served by a party with a document entitled "Notice of Entry" of judgment or a filed-endorsed copy of the judgment, accompanied by proof of service ([CRC 8.822\(B\)](#))
 - 90 days after the entry of judgment ([CRC 8.822\(C\)](#))
