## **Attachment B** - INSTRUCTIONS TO DEPUTY PERSONNEL FOR USING THE ALPHA MDC PERSONNEL CLASSIFICATION CODES

## **Use the classification code relating to your job assignment, not your rank.** Examples:

- A Bonus-1 Watch Deputy or Bonus-1 Station Detective working overtime as a contract city traffic unit would use Class Code "G" designated for "1 Patrol Deputy."
- A Dedicated Unincorporated Area Town Sheriff would use Class Code "C" for "1 B-1 Deputy." Some Sheriff's Stations report these positions as part of their minimum deployment. Concerned deputies need to check with the Operations/Scheduling Staff regarding which classification code to use, i.e., "C" or "G."
- A <u>contracted</u> Bonus-1 Detective (i.e., position is paid by the contract city) would log on as "C."
- A School Resource Deputy or Special Assignment Deputy purchased by the contract city
  would log on as "L." <u>NOTE</u>: SROs purchased directly by the School District log on as
  "X." Please check with your Station Commander or Operations Staff if you are unsure
  how your position is funded.
- "X" designates positions that are not tracked for compliance (Field Sergeants, Watch Commanders, Special Event Overtime i.e., movie jobs or teams temporarily funded with overtime i.e., Summer Crime Enforcement Team).

## **Training Cars and 2-person patrol units:**

- FTOs are **NOT** tracked as B-1s. An FTO working as a 1-person unit will use Code "G."
- 2-person county cars use Code "H" for "2 Patrol Deputies."
- During the first and second phase of training, 2-person <u>contract city cars</u> with an FTO and trainee will use Code "G". Once the patrol trainee has completed the second phase of training, the trainee will begin accounting for his/her minutes while working a <u>contract city car</u>. At this time, the FTO and trainee will begin utilizing Code "H" (refer to Field Operations Directive 07-004).
- 2-person <u>unincorporated area car</u> with an FTO and trainee will use Code "H" for "2 Patrol Deputies regardless of which phase the trainee is in."
- Court Services and Custody Deputy who participate in ride-alongs shall work as a second deputy under direct supervision of a deputy from the host station in an unincorporated area car will use Code "H" for "2 Patrol Deputies." (Refer to Field Operations Directive 05-008)
